

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

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Proof of Vaccination Requirements

A patron seeking access to a business or organization specified in the regulation must provide a receipt that shows that they are fully vaccinated.

After October 22, 2021, in addition to proof of identity, a patron may present a paper or digital version of the PDF receipt or a paper or digital version of the enhanced vaccine certificate with QR code to gain access to designated settings.

An individual is considered fully vaccinated if they have received:

- The full series of a COVID-19 vaccine authorized by Health Canada, or any combination of such vaccines, or
- One or two doses of a COVID-19 vaccine not authorized by Health Canada, followed by one dose of a COVID-19 mRNA vaccine authorized by Health Canada, or
- Three doses of a COVID-19 vaccine not authorized by Health Canada; and
- They received their final dose of the COVID-19 vaccine at least 14 days before providing the proof of being fully vaccinated.
- **A negative COVID-19 test or recent COVID-19 infection is not the same as being fully vaccinated and will not be accepted for entry**

For Guests from outside Ontario or Canada:

- Guests from outside the province or the country will be required to show they are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and identification to enter specified settings.
- Proof of vaccination from outside of Ontario will be accepted if the person's name and date of birth on their identification document matches the vaccination receipt with name and date of birth and if the person is fully vaccinated against COVID-19.
- If the vaccination receipt or proof of identity from out of country is in a language that the business or organization cannot use to verify the documents, the business or organization may request a translated copy in addition to the original receipt.

Medical Exemptions

To review proof of a documented medical reason for not being vaccinated against COVID-19, the Hotel will ensure:

- The name of the person in the written documentation matches the identification provided.
- The physician or registered nurse's in the extended class's information is complete by including:
 - Name and contact information of the physician or registered nurse in the extended class;
 - Logo or letterhead identifying the physician or registered nurse in the extended class;
 - Statement that there is a medical reason for the individual's exemption from being fully vaccinated against COVID-19; and
 - Any effective time-period for the medical reason which includes the date the patron is seeking access to the business or organization.

Proof of Identity

- If somebody is required to be fully vaccinated, they must prove both vaccination status and identity.
- Proof of vaccination will be accepted if the person’s name and date of birth on their identification document matches the vaccination receipt with name and date of birth and if the person is fully vaccinated.
- Acceptable proof of identification: Birth certificate, Citizenship card, Driver’s licence, Government (Ontario or other) issued identification card, including health card², Indian Status Card /Indigenous Membership Card, Passport, Permanent Resident card)
- Proof of identity is also required for all individuals aged 12 to 18 – photo identification is not required.

Note: As per the *Proof of Vaccination Guidance for Businesses and Organizations under the Reopening Ontario Act* relating to sports in an indoor facility:

Effective November 1, 2021, they must implement a policy requiring that each person, 12 years and older, who attends an indoor area of the facility for the purpose of:

1. actively participating in Organized Sports; or
2. coaching, caregiving at, volunteering at, or officiating Organized Sports, provide, at the point of entry, identification and proof of being fully vaccinated against COVID-19 or a valid medical exemption each time they enter.

Areas Impacted

Within the Delta Hotels by Marriott Toronto Airport & Business Centre, there are only limited areas that will require proof of vaccination to enter.

FOOD & BEVERAGE OUTLETS



Proof of Vaccine Required: **NO**

Procedures: As Starbucks operates with take away service, it is not required to ask for proof of vaccination status.



Proof of Vaccine Required: **YES**

Procedures: Restaurant Greeter will check proof of vaccination upon entry to the restaurant prior to seating guests. Take away service will be offered for those not eligible to enter restaurant.



Proof of Vaccine Required: **YES**

Procedures: Since restaurant does not have Greeter at the entrance, the Server/Mixologist will be responsible for checking proof of vaccination upon entering restaurant or at table. Signage will be placed at entry to direct Guests and only those with eligible proof of vaccination will be able to enter.

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HOTEL AMENITIES

HOTEL POOL / HOTEL FITNESS CENTRE

Proof of Vaccine Required: **YES**

Procedures: Upon checking into the Hotel, the Guest Service Agent will outline the provincial requirements relating to proof of vaccination status within the Hotel.

The Guest Service Agent will ask the Guest if they plan on using the Hotel pool of fitness amenities during their stay (Guests will always have the option to decide to use these facilities at a later time).

Should the Guests say they are planning on using these Hotel facilities during their stay, the Guest Service Agent will ask for proof of vaccination as per the provincial guidelines for all members of the Guests party (all Guests 12 years and older).

Once proof of vaccination is provided, the Guest's guestroom key will be programmed with access to the Hotel pool and fitness centre.

CAPACITY LIMITS – Hotel Pool/Fitness Centre

- Capacity mandates are still in effect for the Hotel pool and fitness centre, no matter of vaccination status.
- On peak dates, the Hotel will have staff members in place for monitoring of these entrances to maintain capacity on only allowing guests with acceptable keycards (pre-approved at check in of vaccination status) access to the area.

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HOTEL MEETING & EVENT SPACE

CAPACITY LIMITS – Meeting & Event Space

Indoors & Outdoors: Full capacity permitted. Physical distancing recommended, where possible. Proof of vaccination required. Rooms must be separated by a partition*

All individuals must wear a mask or face covering indoors, as per [Reg. 364/20](#)

All Hotel Meeting Space

Proof of Vaccine Required: YES
Exemptions: NONE (Unless a valid medical exemption is provided)

Meeting Organizer / Convenor will be responsible for communicating to all attendees, PRIOR to arriving at the Hotel, on the provincial requirements for proof of vaccination status. The Hotel is not provided under the regulation any flexibility on the vaccination requirements.

Meeting/Events - Closed to the Public

<p>Groups under 100 people attending</p>	<p>Meeting Organizer / Convenor will be required to verify that all attendees are full vaccinated and meet the provincial guidelines for entry.</p> <p>The meeting Organizer / Convenor will provide documentation that outlines the names and contact information of the attendees (as required for contract tracing by City of Toronto) and attest that all attendees have provided the proof of vaccination.</p> <p>Should the meeting be multiple days, but with the same attendees all days, the meeting Organizer / Convenor can provide a list for the entire timeframe</p>
<p>Groups over 100 people attending</p>	<p>The Hotel will have a designated Staff Member that will attend to the meeting room entry to ask participants for proof of vaccination. Should the event be in multiple rooms, the proof of vaccination will happen at the event check in desk (if applicable) or at a mutually agreed area.</p> <p>The Hotel will only provide minimal staffing to check proof of vaccination at entry at the beginning of the meeting/event. Should additional staffing be required to expedite the process, there will be a charge for this service.</p> <p>The meeting Organizer / Convenor will provide documentation that outlines the names and contact of the attendees (as required for contract tracing by City of Toronto).</p> <p>Should the meeting be multiple days, but with the same attendees all days, the meeting Organizer / Convenor can provide a list for the entire timeframe.</p>

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
